

## Adultery and Infidelity

Scripture Praise Focus: *“Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.”*  
(1 Corinthians 6:18)

Only You can heal the brokenhearted and mend those whose hearts have been wounded through the pain of separation and divorce.

We praise You great and Mighty One for being the Holy Father, Faithful Brother and Ever-Present Comforter to these students. As they experience college life and the hollowness of homesickness and loneliness, we pray You would be with them at all times to bring them comfort, love, peace and joy.
