

## Dating and Sexual Integrity

Scripture Praise Focus: *“When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.”*  
(Isaiah 43:2)

And as they intentionally choose to walk with You and claim victory in sexual integrity, remind them of Your promise to guide their steps and always provide them a way out of temptation, 1 Corinthians 10:13, “No temptation has overtaken You except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let You be tempted beyond what You can bear. But when You are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that You can endure it.”

Father, we ask that You transform the very atmosphere of the college campus. Make the college campus a place where bright minds are sparked with innovation and where new friendships are forged. Let iron sharpen iron and may students and professors come together in the fellowship that only Your presence can bring. We pray that students will encourage one another to choose the path of purity, and be courageous in the face of adversity.
